When surgery is needed, it may require metal pins, screws, or plates to hold the bones in place as the fracture heals. The hardware may be temporary or permanent. Fifth Metatarsal Fracture Surgery - AOFAS The base of the fifth metatarsal is divided into three fracture zones. Zone 1 fractures are avulsion or "chip" fractures that occur at the tip of the base of the fifth metatarsal. These fractures are typically treated without surgery using a cast, boot or hard-soled shoe. These fractures tend to heal within six to eight weeks. Compression Fracture - Symptoms, Causes and Spinal ... The most common type of compression fracture is a wedge fracture, in which the front of the vertebral body collapses but the back does not, meaning that the bone assumes a wedge shape. Sometimes, more than one vertebra fractures, a condition called multiple compression fractures.
